

COMMERCIAL TRAINING TOOLBOX TIPS

Heating Season Checks

Applies to all Lennox Gas/Electric Rooftop Units

Helpful Resources

1. Installation manual for rooftop unit.

Before starting up a gas/electric unit in heating mode, perform the following:

- 1. Check all gas connections for potential leaks.
- 2. Visually inspect flue, burners, heat exchanger, and combustion air blower for obstructions and cracks.
 - a. Clean if needed.
- 3. Check blower belt tension and alignment.
- 4. Disconnect power from the unit and inspect all wire connections for tightness.
- 5. Clean the flame sensor using a non-silica-based tool, not sandpaper or sand cloth.
- 6. Bleed/Purge air from gas lines.
- 7. Check the unit tag for the recommended manifold pressure.
 - a. Adjust manifold pressure only if instructed to do so in the installation instructions.
- 8. Measure and record supply gas inlet pressure.
- 9. Once the burners are lit, check the quality and stability of the burner flames or perform combustion analysis.
- 10. Check the heat rise and ensure it is under the "not to exceed" number listed on the nameplate.




Figure 1. Typical Burner Box Assembly
